

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT ON YOUR PARTICIPATION

1. Entry Division Any changes in the entry division will **not be accepted after application.**

2. **Entry Fee**

Marathon: **10,000 Japanese Yen**

Half Marathon: **3,000 Japanese Yen.**

Please pay the entry fee at Athletes' Registration on November 14th. **Credit cards will be accepted.**

3. **A "First-Come-First-Served" Privilege**

Up to 60 foreign applicants including accompanying persons for T51 & T33 & T52 athletes will be provided with the following privileges of transportation and accommodation in Japan on a **"first-come-first-served" basis** by the Organizer. Please note that **all other athletes and participants outside these 60 will be expected to pay for all costs** during their stay in Japan including accommodation and transportation between Fukuoka Airport and Oita Station.

(Hotel)

Designated Hotel Stay with Breakfast in Japan for 4 Nights.

Privileged applicants (up to 60 eligible participants) will be provided with 4 nights of accommodation with breakfast at a designated hotel. Athletes may stay more than 4 nights, but hotel stay provided by the Organizer will be **limited to 4 nights in total**, and the **cost of their extra stay must be paid by the applicants.**

<Examples>

arrival/ Nov. 12, 2026 departure/ Nov. 16, 2026 (4 nights)

arrival/ Nov. 13, 2026 departure/ Nov. 17, 2026 (4 nights)

arrival/ Nov. 12, 2026 departure/ Nov. 17, 2026 (5 nights) → **one extra night should be paid by participants.**

(Transportation)

Free domestic transportation will be provided **based on your arrival point:**

- Between Oita Airport and the designated hotel, Rembrandt Hotel Oita, in Oita City.
- Between Fukuoka Airport and Oita Station.
- Between Narita International Airport and Haneda Domestic Terminal (**for transit passengers only**).

※Please note that **domestic flights within Japan should be arranged individually**. When booking your flights, please ensure a **minimum transit time of 3 hours** between Haneda International Airport and Haneda Domestic Terminal, and **4.5 hours** between Narita International Airport and Haneda Domestic Airport.

4. **Reservation of local flights in Japan**

Participants must reserve flights within Japan by themselves. Due to domestic transfer arrangements and hotel reservations, we would greatly appreciate receiving information on international flights by **July 31st**. You will be able to arrive in Oita on the same day if you arrive at **Haneda Airport by 17:00** or **Narita Airport by 15:00**. Also, you will have to leave Oita just after the race if your international flight leaves on Monday morning, November 16.

【Access to Oita: 3 Main Routes】

- ▶ Via Haneda Airport (HND) :Fly to Haneda Airport, transfer to a domestic flight to Oita Airport, and then take the shuttle bus to Oita City.
- ▶ Via Narita Airport (NRT) :Fly to Narita Airport. From there, you can take a domestic flight to Oita Airport or Fukuoka Airport. (**Depending on your flight, you may need to transfer to Haneda Airport** to catch a flight to Oita.)
- ▶ Via Fukuoka Airport (FUK): Fly to Fukuoka Airport, and then take the Limited Express train (Sonic) directly to Oita Station.

5. **Racing chair**

Racing wheelchairs **shall meet the regulations** set by the Organizer. (see the Regulations for Wheelchairs)

6. **Helmet**

Wearing a helmet is required.

7. **Cost born by participants**

International airfare, domestic airfare, lunch, dinner, extra stay & breakfast at hotels in Japan, and any personal expenses (such as laundry, snacks and drinks, sightseeing, telephone, compensation for damages to wheelchair equipment, etc.) are participants' responsibility. As mentioned in the above item 3, all the expenses must be paid by the individuals, if they are not included in the early 60 applicants.
